Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

A fine style and a fresh aromatic structure. Redolent floral bouquet (vine flowers, linden), but also fresh fruit notes, slightly lemon-scented, but not excessively so, accompanied by aromas of summer fruits (white peach) and fall fruits (quince, pear), and then rounded out by an exotic suggestion of pineapple. On the palate, the first impression is of fresh pineapple juice, weighty, round and rich, with a lively back taste. The overall impact is long, expansive and smooth. At the finish, the initial fruit notes come to the fore once again.

This wine offers a great deal of complexity and flavor.

Weather conditions

Rainfall: 436 mm

Total production Gironde: 6.80 million hl

Number of days above 30°C/86°F: 21.

Date of the harvest: 13th to 29th September.

Current vintage notes

A mild start to the year, a very wet, hot spring, followed by a dry, scorching summer: such were the weather features of this year, which has become legendary both through its date and the quality of wine produced.

Temperature records were broken: 1.5°C above average over the twelve months – a massive difference. September, hot and dry, followed suit, allowing harvesting to take place in the best possible conditions.



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
