Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

An exceptional bottle. The wine is harmonious, full, complex. In a word, a great wine. Even at its age, the wine is balanced and tastes younger. It is still developing. The fineness and, at the same time, the richness of this wine are remarkable.

A marvelous wine today but can still be aged for a few more years.

Weather conditions

Sum of temperatures : 3198 °C

Rain : 367 mm

Days where temperature above 30 °C : 27

Harvest : from 29/09/1953 to 12/10/1953

Current vintage notes

This is a vintage "made" in August. The month of August was simply fabulous: 15 mm of rain and 15 days with a temperature above 30°C/86°F. September was not as good and it rained during the harvest. There was even a fear of too much heat and some people spoke of "scalded" wines. Many very great wines were produced in 1953.
