Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

The color is normal, developed by time. The structure is light but does not lack charm. The attack is quite agreeable. The aromas of tea are quite evident but there is always also a twinge of slightly green, fresh fruit. The finale is rather dry. This is yet another bottle to drink right away, preferably served at the cellar temperature.

To taste now.

Weather conditions

Sum of temperatures : 3168 °C

Rain : 521 mm

Days where temperature above 30 °C : 18

Harvest : from 25/09/1969 to 04/10/1969

Current vintage notes

A normal year overall. July was hot and dry, August equally so, but on the other hand September was extremely rainy (206 mm. in 23 days of rain). Everything started out well, but the great vintage was destroyed in September. The wines, in the region overall, seem just a little bit washed out.
