Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

The color is rather dense for a thirty year old wine. The structure of the firm tannins in this wine dominates the tasting. It is aromatically marked by a volatile acidity the somewhat presence of which alters to some extent the end of the tasting in the mouth. The softness at the base of this wine does not manage to dissimulate this acidity. Some of the bottles are different from others indicating the possibility of some suspect vats. Many of the bottles hold a certain attraction. The wine must be served rather cool (at the temperature of the cellar).

To drink rather between now and 2015.

Weather conditions

Sum of temperatures : 3184 °C

Rain : 232 mm

Days where temperature above 30 °C : 12

Harvest : from 25/09/1970 to 02/10/1970

Current vintage notes

A perfect year without excess (there were only 12 days of very high temperatures). Very dry summer and a fine month of September. The harvest was very abundant and of very good quality. Excellent wines produced in the entire Bordeaux area.
