Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

The abundant production of the year is evident in this wine. Above all it has been affected by the profuse rains during July and September. The color is light and rather developed. The ever present woodiness is uncertain. As for the nose, one already has the feeling of a dominant old wine. The wine is light and agreeable at the attack but the finale is more delicate and rather drying. This is a bottle to be drunk right away at cellar temperature. It is a good bottle from a difficult vintage.

To taste now.

Weather conditions

Sum of temperatures : 3299 °C

Rain : 354 mm

Days where temperature above 30 °C : 19

Harvest : from 26/09/1973 to 06/10/1973

Current vintage notes

The month of August was very hot (22.8 C average) - the hottest since 1949. On the other hand, July was very rainy (114 mm.), like September. A very abundant harvest, with quality varying widely from region to region.
