Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

This wine has good-looking deep color where the ruby disappears into nuances of more gold. The nose is violent, combining licorice and wild game. In the mouth this tannic complexity is even more noticeable though unable to overcome the lively presence of the pulp of fresh fruit. There is a wonderful concentration of tannin in the mouth. It all seems to be long, complex, unctuous and even silky in the finale with a stretched out note of acidity to give even more zing to the whole. It is a splendid bottle.

To taste rather between now and 2020.

Days where temperature above 30 °C : 16

Harvest : from 23/09/1985 to 08/10/1985

Current vintage notes

A great wine of a late year. A drought never seen, one of the hottest years of this Century but a few days of fog early September helped the grapes that had been dying off to ripen.
