Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

The color which has already slightly evolved does not secrete the intense youthful shade of ruby. As to the nose a trace of ivy vine, perceptible though slight, adds to its complexity. A vestige of smoke is always present. The finale, though not excessively so, is very complex including aromas of blackcurrant and cigar and finishing with a slight trace of acidity. The whole gives an impression of freshness for a fifteen year old wine. This is a very good bottle for this millésime.

To taste now.

Weather conditions

Sum of temperatures : 3262 °C

Rain : 353 mm

Days where temperature above 30 °C : 24

Harvest : from 28/09/1987 to 13/10/1987

Current vintage notes

The weather conditions during the spring and summer were particularly irregular and so was the ripening. There were ten exceptionally hot days in September and bad weather during the harvest.
