Château La Mission Haut-Brion's tasting notes :

This wine has a handsome color deep and mature. The nose finds that the perfect maturity of the fruit is dominating the tasting. One even finds the softness of the wine in the nose. In the mouth the subtleties of the aromas evolve bit by bit. The ripe tannins make up a taut and fleshy base. Nevertheless all is harmoniously melded together. One notes the scent of cigar, cedar wood, an unusually exotic touch of vanilla, cloves and orange peel, ending with a strong whiff of truffle. All these evolve together and give a sensation of silky unctuousity. This is a legendary bottle.

To taste rather between now and 2030.

Harvest : from 29/08/1989 to 20/09/1989

Current vintage notes

Historically an early vintage. The growing season was particularly hot, sunny and dry providing ideal conditions for budding, flowering, veraison, maturity and harvest. An exceptional year produced an exceptional wine.
